The VLC-1 amplifier circuits have been exclusively licensed from D.W.Fearn. For more detailed technical specifications, history and information on the VLC-1 preamp design, please refer to the D.W.Fearn VT-1 manual found at www.dwfearn.com.

In general, for superior sound, we recommend connecting the VLC-1 directly to your recorder with no processing.

When using the line input, it is recommended to engage the -20dB pad in order to provide a better level in most circumstances.

The VLC-1 features a **locking +48v phantom power switch**. This prevents the phantom power from being accidentally engaged by being bumped unintentionally. This is particularly useful when using condenser microphones, or to prevent accidental engagement when using ribbon microphones. To actuate, *gently* pull out the switch while flipping.

The VLC-1 may only be serviced by a factory-approved technician. DO NOT REMOVE TOP COVER. There exists a high risk of electric shock that could result in serious injury or death. Do not expose to moisture.

The VLC-1 has been specifically designed to be operated from an intuitive approach, rather than an analytical one. Hence, there is an absence of technical values printed on the front panel and in this manual. Always use your ears to determine settings for desired results.
